This May program explores the social, cultural and geographical history of the city of Paris from the Middle Ages to the present through the study of a number of key events in the city's rich history. Students will focus on different events and their geographical context within the city, thereby exploring the city not just from century to century but from neighborhood to neighborhood. Through museums and monument visits, shows, restaurants, discussions with Parisians, walks, subway rides, short trips to Versailles and Giverny, students will understand what the city of Paris has become.
