

PhD Admissions Requirements Checklist	
	Submit your online application and all materials by November 30
	Statement of intent (1 to 2 pages)
	Curriculum vitae or resume (1 to 2 pages)
	Academic writing sample in English
	Academic writing sample in French/Italian
	Three letters of recommendation. Recommenders will be automatically contacted with a link to submit their letters when you submit your application.
	Official transcripts for <u>each</u> college or university attended.
	GTA Application Form (for students who wish to be considered for a Graduate Teaching Associateship)
	International students must submit Proof of English Proficiency. To be considered "official," scores must be sent directly from the testing agency to Ohio State.
	Applicants who are citizens of or who have received a bachelor's degree (or higher) from one of these English-speaking countries are exempt: Australia, Belize, the British Caribbean and British West Indies, Canada (except Quebec), England, Guyana, Ireland, Liberia, New Zealand, Scotland and Wales.
	If required, GRE Scores must be sent electronically from the testing agency. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is required only of applicants (domestic or international) whose Grade Point Average from all previous higher-education institutions, when converted to the American 4 point scale by the Graduate School, is lower than 3.0.
